**Bowling Pins-Inclimate weather, be prepared to shoot CF pistols (non-magnums) at plate racks**

Targets: Bowling Pins on tables at 26 feet for Handguns and Shotguns

Firearms: Centerfire Pistol, Revolver, 9mm (9 Pin), Shotgun Pump and Semi-Auto (Buckshot only)

Classes: Pistol Iron, Pistol Optic/Electronic, Revolver Iron, Revolver Optic/Electronic, 9mm Parabellum, Pocket Pistol, Shotgun: Pump, Shotgun Semi-Auto,

**Bowling Pins with Pistol Caliber Carbine/ and Centerfire Rifle (all sights and actions run the same class)**

Rifle (Centerfire): 5 Bowling Pins at 25 Yards

**50-100 Yard Steel Plates**

Rifle (Centerfire): 5 steel plates ranging from 50 to 100 yards up to 30-06 (No steel or penetrators)

Classes: Semi-Auto and Manual- Any Sights

Handgun (Centerfire): 5 steel plates ranging from 25 to 75 yards

Classes: All Actions and Sights are in the same class

<p><b><u>Falling Plate Rack</u></b> -Times: 10AM to 2PM Firearms: Centerfire Handgun (No Magnums) &amp; .22LR Handgun, 22LR Rifle or Shotgun with&lt; #6 shot or smaller Classes: Handgun Iron Sight shoots 1 less plate than Optic/Electronic Sights: Iron and Optic/Electronic shoot together for rifle Dates: 5/8P, 6/12R, 7/10S, 8/14P, 9/11R, 10/9S (P=.22LR Pistol, R=.22 Rifle, and S=Shotgun)</p>	<p><b><u>Single Action 3 Gun</u></b> Single action cowboy revolvers, double action revolvers shot as single action (2 needed). The rifle may be lever, pump, or bolt action, (no semi-autos). Shotguns may be single barrel (each shot would need to be loaded one at a time) double barrel, bolt or pump, (no semi-autos). Date: 5/23</p>

<p><b><u>3 Gun Action Match</u></b> Firearms: CF Pistol (no Magnums), Shotgun (Birdshot ≤ #6) and Rifle Classes: Iron and Optic/Electronic based on Pistol Targets: Paper and Steel 10-75 yards Date: 8/1</p>	<p><b><u>Precision Bench Rest</u></b> Firearms: Centerfire Rifle and .22LR Rifle Classes: Unlimited, Hunting Rifle, Military Rifle, .22LR Rifles, Sights: Optic/Electronic Allowed (except for military class); Targets: Paper at 100 yards Date: 6/6,</p>
<p><b><u>Prodigious Ammo Pistol Action Match (No Magnums)</u></b> Firearms: Centerfire (+ extra mags / speed loaders) Classes: Semi-Auto &amp; Revolver, Iron &amp; Optic/Electronic Targets: A LOT of Steel targets Date: 4/18</p>	<p><b><u>Iron Sighted pre-1945 and Optical Sighted and Modern Military Rifle Match</u></b> This match involves shooting military rifles (or their look-alikes) at paper targets at 100 yards. The match requires shooting from four positions with generous time limits. Date: 8/22</p>
<p><b><u>Rim Fire Sporter Rifle Match (3 Position)</u></b> 22LR Rifle (like stock Ruger 10/22, etc.) Other 22 LR Rifles will be grouped by rifle weight Date: 10/17</p>	<p><b><u>Dueling Tree Match</u></b> Centerfire pistol, Timed action, and 10 shot magazines Dates: 7/25, 9/5</p>
<p><b><u>.22LR Silhouette Match</u></b> Firearms: .22LR Rifle &amp; Pistol Classes: Iron &amp; Optic/Electronic, Standing Rifle, Standing or Freestyle classes with Pistol Targets: Steel 25,50,75,100 yards Date: 5/16</p>	<p><b><u>Shotgun Action Match</u></b> Classes for each shotgun type, used mostly for home defense, any gauge, Semi- and pump. Any optics. Targets: Lots of steel, maybe paper. (Birdshot ≤ #6 ) Date: 10/3</p>
<p><b><u>.22LR 2-Gun Action Match</u></b> Firearms: .22LR Rifle &amp; .22LR Pistol Classes: Iron and Optic/Electronic (based on Pistol) Sights: Iron and Optic/Electronic Targets: Steel 10-50 yards. Dates: 6/20, 8/8</p>	<p><b><u>Shotgun Falling Plates</u></b> Firearms: Any action type using #6 birdshot or smaller Classes: All action &amp; sight types run in the same class No plates are given for Iron or Optic. Dates: Now part of some Falling Plate rack shoots.</p>
